



Chamber's Nuclear Generation Working Principles:

The Greater Lehigh Valley Chamber of Commerce recognizes the challenges facing our nuclear electricity generation plants and the important role this fleet plays in maintaining a diverse and comprehensive electricity generation strategy. Given nuclear's important role, we believe nuclear energy must continue to be a viable energy source. We support the following:

- A diverse mix of electric power generation fuels is the best strategy to achieve energy independence, maintain grid stability, and provide the necessary grid security.
- Keeping electricity costs competitive and affordable to support regional economic development.
- Additional market mechanisms may be necessary to better compensate nuclear generation for the value it provides in being reliable and emission-free.
- Investments in innovative technologies to support nuclear power generation are essential.
